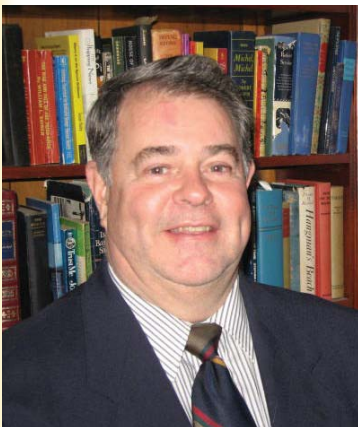
## Announcing Larry Honey, P.Eng, P.Ag. : Chair of the Fundraising Committee
