Kentville Library to Move: Update

Kentville, Nova Scotia: Kentville Library is moving! A long-anticipated move for the Kentville Library is now in the works. The last open day of the Kentville Library in the current location, 95 Cornwallis Street, will be Saturday, August 6th.

The library will be closed August 7-14. The outdoor book drop will be available for book return during this time. The temporary location, "Kentville Lite" will be in the lower level at 440 Main Street (former United Church building). The planned opening date is August 15. The hours & phone number will remain the same at the Kentville Lite location. We anticipate being in the temporary location for 2-3 months while renovations are being made to the library space on the upper level of the building.

The temporary location will be accessible, with washrooms and parking available for patrons.

Since our temporary location is smaller, we will be operating with a reduced collection, however, our library users may place a hold on any item in our AVRL collection to be picked up at the Kentville Lite location.

Public computers and WIFI will be available. Programming will be limited in the temporary location. Updates to our Fall programming schedule will be announced at a later date. Summer Reading prizes may be picked up at any other Annapolis Valley Regional Library location during the closed dates.
